#### Course Description

The two-day *Long-read Data Analysis Workshop* aims to introduce attendees to genome assembly using long-read data. As part of this workshop participants will perform a hands-on comparison between short and long-read microbial genome assemblies.

This workshop will consist of a mixture of lectures, hands-on practical sessions, and open discussions.

#### Target Audience

Long-read Data Analysis workshop is designed for bench scientists, PhD students and early career postdoctoral researchers who are working with or are interested in using long-read data in their research and have little to no bioinformatics experience. The workshop utilises the Linux command-line, although no programming experience is required familiarity will be useful.
